Create a virtual project community

Part of what makes a project successful is to allow team members several choices for communication, depending on the need. eRoom is ideal for the virtual team because it offers many ways for team members to come to closure on key issues. Multi-threaded discussions, chat, polling and paging provide plenty of flexibility for team members.

Move at the speed of change

Moving beyond the walls of the enterprise, while maintaining its infrastructure, is the key to rapid-cycle development. eRoom is ideal for rapid-cycle projects: It absorbs and disseminates information as fast as it's generated. Get productive — day one.

When your kickoff meeting ends, create a new eRoom. It's a secure workplace on the Web for all your project work. Create the look, the structure of the folders and discussions, and you're on your way. No waiting for IT to get something set up for you. Put all your work in and it becomes instantly accessible to your team members. New team members come up to speed instantly just by getting access and looking around.

Bring new members on board quickly and easily

When you need to add a person to the group, eRoom sends an invitation with the eRoom's URL and user name; new users simply click the embedded link and log in. You can even see who's logged on at any time, for a quick real-time discussion. Once your eRoom is established, the team itself decides how to use it—and who has access. Start with a template, or build your own. Embed your work process in the eRoom to ensure uniformity.

No training required

What distinguishes eRoom is its exceptional ease of use and flexibility; anyone with a browser can use and manage it immediately. Drag a document as-is from your desktop to the eRoom—no HTML conversion is required—it becomes instantly available to everyone on the team.

Include everyone, everywhere

eRoom 4.0 now provides a way to get all members of a team involved regardless of operating system or browser version. Users can run either in "browser-only mode", which requires no client installation and runs on all platforms, or with a browser plug-in on Windows for an enhanced user experience.



COutlook integration

Use Outlook 2000 as your personal project central. Run eRooms directly in the Outlook frame.



Drag and drop

If you want to bring a document into eRoom, just drag it and drop it there. To get to the eRoom, log into the URL you're issued when you become a member.

>Paging

Contact other eRoom users, even if they're not logged on, by paging them.

They're notified instantly from their desktop.



Review. discuss. and vote

Review the documents and project notes on your own, share your thoughts via on-line discussions or chat, then vote to close the issue down. eRoom is a decision-oriented solution, and helps your entire team come to consensus and action faster. Your team stays focused and efficient.

Know when things change — instantly

Sometimes, you only want to return to the eRoom when something has changed. eRoom has several ways to notify team members when its contents have changed. Notification can be instantaneous or via nightly e-mail; it's up to you. eRoom clearly marks the items that have changed since you last visited — so you can stay up-to-date at a glance.

Integrate with Microsoft Office 2000

For those users using Microsoft Office 2000, eRoom 4.0 allows you to save all your MS Office files directly into an eRoom. You can use Outlook as your personal "project central," a personal dashboard you use to track your mail, tasks, contacts, and project eRooms. Synchronize your Outlook tasks with eRoom.

Need it? Find it!

eRoom's full-text search capability lets you search the entire contents of an eRoom, or search across multiple eRooms, by date, author, read or unread status, and text. It also searches the document content as well as member profiles, and allows people to associate custom tags with objects for further retrieval. Or, you can find items via a pictorial map, which gives you a hierarchical view of all the information in the eRoom.

Administer eRoom remotely with powerful tools

The eRoom Administration Console is now Web-enabled, allowing remote administration of eRoom servers. Administrative reports provide a comprehensive picture of who is using eRoom and how. Views range from bird's eye to detailed information using Excel pivot tables. The reports are also easily customized.

Work with your data repositories

Enterconnect,™ eRoom's programmable enterprise connector, makes it possible to move your eRoom information right into your existing document management systems, groupware, or other repositories (including Microsoft Exchange). This allows your corporation to archive and retrieve important project data.



Discussion and voting

Join a discussion at any time, or branch off into new topics asynchronously or in real time. eRoom also lets you poll members, to vote on issues.




Version control
